Netherhall School – Physical Education Department

This is an exciting time to join Netherhall School, rated Good by Ofsted for the first time in February 2018, named Cumbrian Secondary School of the Year, host to Cumbrian Secondary School Teacher of the Year and Cumbrian Secondary School Student of the Year, with a sixth form that has recently doubled in size and a rapidly increasing number of students on roll. Sport is a real strength of the school.

The physical education department is an experienced and growing department of enthusiastic specialist PE teachers, which includes a significant contribution from other school staff to extracurricular sport. PE is an extremely popular option choice in Key Stages 4 and 5, with superb BTEC and Level 3 results, while also having very good school to local club links.
